Approval of minutes of last meeting



Questions / Items raised:

- o From last time:
 - Broadacres Grass area around the tree near the entrance to the hall now
 Cut
- New Items
 - Footpaths
 - Elphin Bridge to Thormanby. This has been in action for 6 months now with diversion notices in place from the field entrance near the barns, but with apparently, little progress being made.
 - However, it transpires that a new concrete support structure has already been put into place and a superior bridge is now in place.
 Additionally Dan reported shortly after the meeting that the crossing over the "Stell" on the way to the Elphin Bridge is planned to be updated by Christmas.
 - Kevin & Sarah to do a full footpath audit
 - Erica to review the Angram Grange route
 - Cutting of the grass extending out from the Green onto the footpath
 - o Council to cut?
 - Footpath quality throughout the Village is now quite poor
 - Margaret confirmed that the last resurfacing was done in 2000
 - Noted that both Coxwold and Husthwaite have recently had improvement works
 - o A request to be submitted to the Council
 - Footpath extension for outside John Butler / Sarah's properties
 - Can this also be requested from the Council

Chairperson's Report / JB Actions from previous meeting:

- Flyer Speeding / Mobiles / Safety / Litter / Salt Bin
 - o Drafted, amendments received & noted from the meeting
- Salt Bins
 - Should we invest in a second Saltbin for the Robson Tractors junction?
 - Meeting decided against:
 - 1. However, sacks of salt will be placed into the phone box for use
 - 2. Should villagers at the East end of the Village find having salt useful for the Winter then a second bin could be invested in
 - This adds £225 to the Community charge in the first year.
 - SL has emptied the Croft Lane saltbin ready for a refill and it has been refilled.
 - The excess salt will be used for the Phone box supply for this year
- New Bench for outside the Village Hall
 - Slab foundations Kevin & James still to do, and for a picnic bench for the Hall (KH/SL)
- Jubilee Tree
 - Plague to be fixed along with Bench when ready (KH)
- Litter Bin for outside the Village Hall
 - To order once Bench is in place (KH)
- Local Plan
 - Nothing to report
- Streetlights
 - All working
 - However, a new streetlight outside of Simon's workshop at the top of Croft Lane was suggested, as this is a dark spot in the evenings.
 - Area circled in Red



- Budget Plan
 - To use the Link and Facebook to gather any ideas for plans / projects (KH)
 - Wi-fi for Village Hall suggested (KH)
 - Village Committee rejected this idea / expense at this stage as no enquiries for hiring the Village Hall had ever requested WiFi connectivity.
 - 3G/4G phone coverage is available so internet access can be achieved if ever needed.
